Ability to model, build, and execute automatic workflows for the purpose of managing content-centric processes.

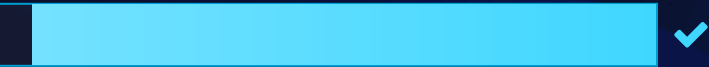
